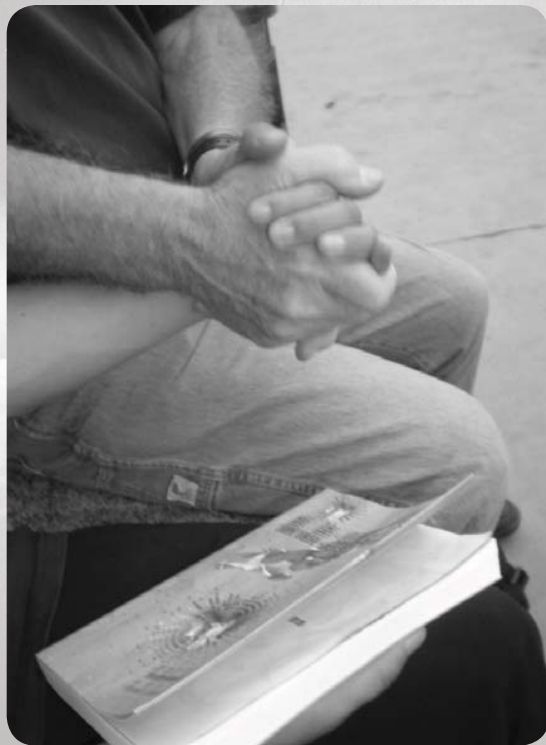

Some are weekly ministries and some are mission team projects or trips. Pray about your personal involvement in one or more of these ministries. LOCAL

Our mission is to reach people for Christ and walk with them to maturity. Our mission begins in our own community.



CHAMPS CAMP - MARCH 19-23.

Serve with our student ministry over Spring Break to reach children in our community. Help with meals, driving a van or bus, sports instruction, overnight sponsors, clean-up teams and more.

NORTHWEST BAPTIST TUTORING MINISTRY - WEDNESDAYS

Tutoring for elementary students offers help in all school subjects. This ministry has seen several students and parents become Christians through their interactions with the volunteers. Change the future - invest in a child!

THE CLUB - WEDNESDAYS

This after-school club, sponsored by our partner Community Advance, is for Taft Middle School students to provide an environment for mentors and students to interact and develop life skills. The students eat dinner with NWBC families and then transition into the church's weekly activities.

HELPING HANDS - TUESDAYS AND THURSDAYS

Tutoring for Taft Middle School students is a practical way to help with school work and to show the love of Christ.

INTERNATIONAL FRIENDSHIP PARTNER MINISTRY

American families, singles, and college students connect with an international student once a month during the academic year. Include the student in your normal activities such as a meal, a holiday, a hobby, a school activity, etc. This hospitality ministry is a rich cultural exchange for everyone involved.

COMMUNITY OUTREACH

Volunteers are needed for a variety of significant NWBC and Community Advance ministries on a weekly or event basis:

NORTHWEST NETWORK CONGREGATIONS

Do you sense God's calling to serve among a particular cultural group? The Northwest Network of congregations has a place for you to serve through ministries such as helping with conversational English, tutoring, transportation, childcare, learning a language and more. Current ministries are among Spanish, Korean, Chinese, Vietnamese, Burmese, refugees, and others.

NATIONAL

We are passionate about reaching not only our own city but partnering with others to reach strategic cities in North America.

MISSION ARLINGTON YOUTH TEAM - JULY 22-27

Middle school, high school students and sponsors will serve with this dynamic DFW ministry to engage in outreach activities such as backyard Bible clubs, a food and clothing ministry, servant evangelism, and other community ministries. Low cost per person.



PHILADELPHIA METRO MISSION TEAM - SUMMER DATES TO BE DETERMINED

Adults and student volunteers will serve with Gibson Largent, a former NWBC staff member, through a new church plant in suburban Philly. Ministries will include surveying, prayer walking, building relational bridges for the gospel, doing community service/servant evangelism, training their core team and more. Cost about \$700.

CHICAGO MISSION PROJECT - OPEN DATES

Volunteers have opportunities to serve with Northwest's Scott Alexander through a church planting team in suburban Chicago. They will serve Hindu, Muslim, and refugee families through neighborhood ministries, servant evangelism, prayer walking and more. Cost about \$700.

INTERNATIONAL

Our on-going international focus is New City, an unreached city in East Asia, that we adopted in 2007. We also partner with other organizations, including some Global Impact guests, to mobilize volunteers for other global mission opportunities.

NEW CITY-EAST ASIA ENGLISH TEACHER TRAINING TEAMS

TEAM 1 - MAY 18 - JUNE 3

TEAM 2 - JUNE 29 - JULY 15

TEAM 3 - JULY 27 - AUGUST 12

Each team of 4-8 volunteers will train local private English school teachers and teach interactive English to students, mostly children. If you speak English, you can do this! Being in the city will open opportunities to engage teachers, parents and adults to build bridges to share testimonies and the good news. Volunteers will also engage in prayer walking and encouraging local believers. Cost about \$3,000.

CHIAPAS MEXICO MISSION - JULY 21-29

This will be a great first mission trip experience. Volunteers will serve with Greg and Michelle McClanahan (Global Impact guests) and Harvest Evangelistic Association. The team will engage in pioneer missions and evangelism in remote Indian villages to share the gospel through film outreach, drama, children's ministry, meeting medical and construction needs and more. Cost about \$1,200.

NEW CITY-EAST ASIA KIDS GOLF CAMP - JULY 15-26

Help kids learn how to play golf. 4-6 volunteers will also interact with their parents, businessmen and city officials to develop friendship and look for opportunities to share their testimonies and the gospel. Conversational English groups in schools and clubs and potential business seminars may also be part of this trip. Cost about \$3,200.



INDIA MEDICAL MISSION - OPEN DATES

Dr. Brent Brown is working with Alpha Ministries to establish medical clinics to support their work in India. Medical and non-medical volunteers are needed to help with basic health education, provide training and counsel to help improve local health conditions, assist in local health facilities, and share the love of Christ in tangible ways. Cost about \$3,000.



NEW CITY-EAST ASIA PRAYER, OUTREACH AND TRAINING TEAMS - OPEN DATES

Small teams of 2-6 volunteers are needed for various targeted ministries in the city: Prayer walk, initiate relationships to share Christ, help disciple new believers, train local leaders, join conversational English groups, engage in a Christmas project, teach a business seminar, and more. Cost about \$2,800.

NEW CITY-EAST ASIA ENGLISH TEACHERS - ONE YEAR OR LONGER

English teachers for university students and children are in high demand. These positions require a bachelor's degree and will pay enough for a person or couple to live in the city to be a witness for Christ.
